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## **“BEST START”**

### **What is Best Start all about?**

- ◇ The “Best Start” program provides an opportunity for children to further develop and practise some skills necessary for school. Language, fine and gross motor, literacy and numeracy readiness are a focus of the program. Children will participate in activities to assist their readiness to start formal work at the beginning of their Prep year.
  
- ◇ The “Best Start” program is designed to make sure your child is fully supported in their transition between kinder and primary school. We aim to have your child feeling safe and secure in the school environment before they begin school. The additional “school readiness” skills taught in “Best Start” will ensure they are off to a flying start at school!
  
- ◇ “Best Start” is also designed to be a supportive transition for families of students. Parent information sessions, covering a range of topics, will be held throughout the term. These sessions will enable our families to become familiar with the routines of our school prior to the start of the formal school year.



### **When will it operate?**

We will be running a “Best Start” session once per week.

Wednesdays : 9:15am—11:15am

### **When will it start?**

Our program will begin in term 4 on Wednesday 23rd October, running for 8 weeks, concluding on Tuesday 10th December (State-wide Transition Day).

### **Who can come?**

Any students who are intending to attend Prep at Lang Lang Primary School in 2020 may attend the program.

### **What will it cost?**

There is NO COST for students to attend the program. We do ask that children bring their own water bottle, piece of fruit/veg and a small, healthy snack.

### **Where will it be held?**

The program will make use of all our school facilities including the library, art room, multipurpose room and sports shed.

### **Who will be taking the program?**

Our program is facilitated by a highly experienced Early Years / Prep teacher. All Lang Lang Primary School staff and current students will have opportunities throughout the program to build positive relationships with our Best Start students.

### **What do I need to do?**

Complete a “Best Start” or School enrolment form and return to the school by 31st July. School tours are available by contacting the office and making an appointment.
